From the ones selected to be included in the exhibition, she chose the following for the four awards. They were as follows:

Gold award of \$500 went to Cindy Handy for her painting *Vivid Tangle*. Silver award of \$350 went to Stephanie Gabris, for her photograph *Segments*. Bronze award of \$250 went to Phil Merlino for his photograph *Mount Adams Tower*. Finally, Honorable Mention award of \$100 went to Jenny Horstman for her painting *Still Life* #2.

Thanks to the many people involved in making this a successful event. The exhibition will continue through June 14, open Thursday, Friday and Saturday from 12 to 5 p.m. It is a beautiful show not to be missed.

Thanks to a grant from the Stewart's Holiday Match, North Country Arts was able to present scholarships to five high school students who were accepted into the Hyde Collection Annual High School Art Exhibition. The students receive an annual NCA membership and vouchers to participate in six non-juried North Country Arts exhibitions and one juried exhibition in 2025 or 2026 at its Gallery 120 in the Shirt Factory, Glens Falls. It allows the students to learn what is required to participate in a professional art gallery and to show their work along with many varied artists from the region.

The five students chosen this year are as follows: Estella Kvintaug, 11th grade, Cambridge Jr. and Sr. High School for The Rabbit Hole in white charcoal; Elizabeth Stevens, 10th grade, Glens Falls High School for Central Park in acrylic; Madeline Buck, 11th grade, Queensbury High School for Multiplicity in digital photography; Theresa Richter, 10th grade, Saratoga Springs High School for Front Page Feline in Prismacolor pencil and graphic; and Felicity Lilac, 10th grade, South Glens Falls High School for Radiant Shapes in oil pastels. Dr. Jacquiline Touba, founder of the World Awareness Children's Museum and Board member of North Country Arts was the Juror.






Member News
