After NCA's successful one week exhibition, *Climate Change* at The Hyde Collection in November, 2024, NCA was able to secure a full-month exhibition for 2025. The Hyde Collection accepted to allow NCA to hold its exhibition, *Reflections*, in the month of July when they were open an extra day and had an abundance of tourists as well as locals at the time. However, they were so pleased with NCA's exhibition that they decided to use it themselves. The reception was held on July 10th, which was a free day so that visitors could also visit other parts of the museum without charge. Having this exhibition at The Hyde Collection was an opportunity to expose artist members to a whole new audience and it was a prestigious place to be able to show one's art.

Since the museum plans to use the space for its own exhibitions, there is less opportunity for NCA to exhibit but the organization was able to secure a space for 2026 from November 5 to 29. We had four award winners (\$100.00 each) as listed below:



Jacquiline Touba and Dennis Wilson to exhibit Medallions in Persian Rugs - Sept. — Nov. 2025

Past President and Past Treasurer of the NCA Board, Jacquiline Touba, Ph.D. and NCA member and 2nd floor NCA Gallery volunteer Dennis Wilson are having a joint exhibition of **Medallions** in Persian Rugs at Crandall Public Library, 2nd Floor. The two artists will be pairing the art of Dr. Touba's watercolor batiks and Mr. Wilson's chip carvings of the same image. The original pen and ink drawings by Dr. Touba were based on medallions found in rugs from major cities in Iran such as Kerman, Kashan, Qom, Tabriz, Naien and Heriz. Dr. Touba is also the founder of the World Awareness Children's Museum and co-founder of the Glens Falls Arts District. Mr. Wilson is a retired English teacher and currently teaches chip carving at the Adirondack Folk School in Lake Luzerne. The exhibit is sponsored by the Folklife Center of Crandall Public Library. A meet the artists reception will take place on September 18 from 5-7 p.m. on the 2nd floor near the Holden Room. The exhibition will run until the end of November and is open during library hours.
